

Visalia Tourism Market Indicators

February 2024

Visalia hotels occupied 56.1% of available rooms at an average rate of \$167 generating a \$94 RevPAR in February. Room supply increased 8.2% YOY while demand fell -0.7% against last February. ADR was down -2% YOY. Given the supply growth and rate decline, RevPAR fell -10.1% YOY but room revenue was down just -2.7% from last year, closing the month at \$3.9 million.

Visalia hotels did have the lowest occupancy among the competitive set, with Ontario hotels registering the highest value at 65%. Yosemite hotels had the highest ADR and RevPAR followed by Visalia. Fresno hotels occupied 57% of availability with \$118 ADR and \$67 RevPAR.

TSA throughput at FAT grew 25.6% over last year, well ahead of statewide (+9% YOY) and national (+11% YOY) trends. The Leisure and Hospitality industry held 14K jobs in Visalia during February, up 0.7% YOY but growing at a slower rate than Total Nonfarm employment which gained 2.4% YOY.

Travel price index inflation across the US decelerated in February 2024. Negative price pressures (as YOY % Change) stemmed from lodging prices (-0.9%), motor fuel prices (-4.2%) and airline fares (-6.1%). Meanwhile price growth for recreation services (+4.5%) and food and beverages (+4.5%) slowed in February.

Hotels across the US registered 58.9% occupancy in February, down 1.8% from one year ago, and relatively unmoved from percent change vs. 2023 as of last month (-1.7% in January). Average daily rates grew 3.9% to \$158, while RevPAR increased 2.0% YOY to \$93.

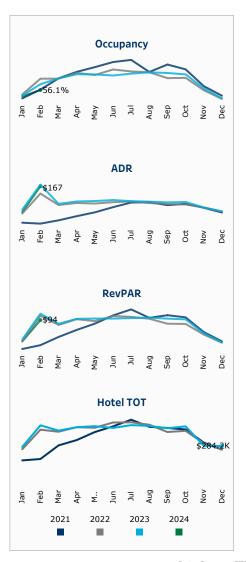

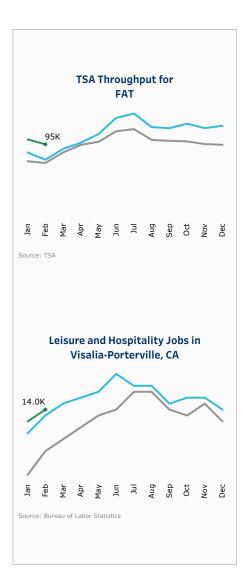

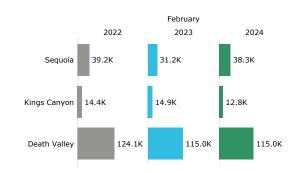

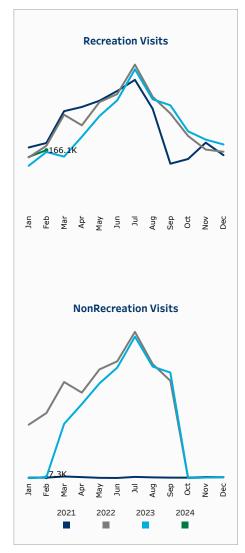
