2.	Financials	The 2024 year-end financial reports were presented for review and approval. The financial reports reflected VTMD Spending more than \$47,000 than received in collections. The additional expenses, from retained earnings, was primarily dedicated to special marketing campaigns and destination development initiatives, including the Destination by Design study. The expense percentage by class vs Management District Plan allocation: Collection fee: 0.96% (1%) Admin/Operations: 13% (15%) Marketing: 78.62% (69%) Destination Development: 12.89% (10%) Chagan motioned to approve the 2024 year end financials, Ramos seconded the motion.
