3. SEKI Report	<ul> <li>Thank you for Congressman Costa's Trek to the Trees. Discussion on workforce housing and in Park transportation conversion grant along with projects pending or underway. City discussed return of Kids in the Trees program with Sequoia Parks Conservancy.</li> <li>Dark Sky Festival is September 12-14, 2025.</li> <li>Campgrounds are in the process of closing for the season.</li> <li>Crystal Cave closed on 9/7 to work on repairing the road.</li> <li>Seasonal staffing are ending their season, leaving behind the permanent staff, which is down 45% due to hiring freeze, to keep visitor services going.</li> <li>No current workforce housing issues due to hiring freeze.</li> <li>Jim Henson Co. is producing a new Muppet show. Pilot episode features SEKI and will shoot in late October. Sequoia will be the first park featured, focused on Awe and Inspiration for Kids. Working with Visit Visalia for production team accommodations.</li> <li>Mineral King Road repairs are ahead of schedule. The first year work continues into December, with the team projecting a 2-year project versus a 3- year project.</li> <li>October 1, 2025 – soft launch of online public lands passes.
