2.		Oneto presented the October financials. Money was transferred from savings to checking. Oneto recommends closing the Valley Strong Money Market and moving the money to Central Valley Community Bank. Chagan motioned to approve the October financials and close the Valley Strong Credit Union Money Market. The funds will be moved to the VCVB primary banking institution.  Discussion of average monthly operational expenses of \$10,000 with an additional \$25,500 in payroll. Monthly income from TMD is \$71,000. TMD.  Deissler seconded the motion. City Manager and Convention Center Manager met with representatives from the VCVB Board, John Oneto and Anil Chagan.</li> <li>Discussion points: <ul> <li>VCVB defaulted on 2024 contract by not fulfilling 7300 New Room Night goal.</li> <li>VCVB needs to hire a dedicated convention sales person.</li> <li>VCVB Board Meetings need to focus on convention sales not tourism marketing.</li> <li>In 2026, provided the City accepts the VCVB Sales Plan, the New Room Night Goal will be 3500.</li> <li>VCVB and City Liaison will be quarterly to review new room night attainment and sales tactics/efforts.</li> <li>There is no contract with the City for 2025. 5. Director Appointment	Nominations to increase the Board size from 7 members to 9 include Samantha Rummage-Mathias from the Visalia Convention Center and Carrie Groover from Visalia Marriott. Chair Nelsen alerted the need to amend the by-laws to allow another hotelier on the VCVB board; from 30% to 40% from a single industry. This action will be included on the December meeting agenda along with increasing the number of Visalia Tourism Marketing District Board Members.  Oneto voted to approve the nomination of Rummage-Mathias to the VCVB Board. Chagan seconded the motion. Motion Carried.
