SEQUOIA SHUTTLE

Enjoying Sequoia National Park has never been easier! We'll do the driving while you relax aboard the Sequoia Shuttle on a journey from Visalia through Sequoia groves in the nation's second oldest National Park. Once inside the park, you'll benefit from free in-park shuttle routes that take visitors to popular destinations including the General Sherman Tree, Moro Rock, Crescent Meadow and more!

KAWEAH OAKS PRESERVE

Kaweah Oaks Preserve, a 344-acre nature preserve, protects one of the last remaining valley oak riparian forests in the San Joaquin Valley. When you walk along the trails at Kaweah Oaks Preserve, you can easily imagine how this area looked before it was settled 100 years ago. More than 300 animal and plant species live, feed, or reproduce at the nature preserve, including gray foxes, great horned owls, Nuttall's woodpeckers, wild grapevines, willow thickets, and majestic valley oaks.



MINERAL KING ADVENTURE

Take a scenic drive to Mineral King in Sequoia National Park for sweeping views and vistas of the East Fork of the Kaweah River and adjacent mountains. The road is not for the faint of heart, but some of the nation's most stunning high country waits to reward visitors who make the trek.
